Sunday

7:00pm: Meet & Greet Social at the main fireplace in the lobby

Monday

9:30am – 2:00pm: Nature Hike – easy to moderate*

Join your activities guide for a relaxing and educational nature hike in Rocky Mountain National Park. The route covers 3 – 4 miles of easy to moderate terrain. Pack a bag lunch, enough water to stay nicely hydrated and your camera for this enjoyable trek in the park.

7:00pm – 8:00pm: S'mores & hot chocolate

Because we know you can never have enough chocolate, we again have the S'mores and hot chocolate by the main fireplace in the lobby. If you were not able to attend the social on Sunday night, this is a perfect opportunity to get acquainted with fellow guests and find out more about all that the Historic Craggs Lodge and the Estes Park area have to offer.

Tuesday

8:30am – 1:00pm: Fly-Fishing*

The Estes Park area boasts world-class fly-fishing among the backdrop of various scenic locations. Try your luck wading the Gold Medal waters of the Big Thompson or hike up to a crystal clear high mountain lake to fish for the rare Greenback Cutthroat. Rental gear is available for those people who want to give fly-fishing a try. Don't worry, most people we take out have never fly-fished before. If you want to learn the basics, there is no better place to learn than Estes Park! With a FREE guide, the price is right, too! If you have an enjoyable time, please consider a gratuity for your guide.

9:30am – 10:30am: Yoga by the Pool (\$10)*

Join one of the local Estes Park yoga instructors for a relaxing beginning to your day. The class meets out by the pool, which is an ideal location with the Continental Divide of the Rocky Mountains as your backdrop.

3:00pm – 5:00pm: The Story of the Greenback Cutthroat*

The Greenback Cutthroat was once thought to be extinct. Now this beautiful trout, which is also the State Fish of Colorado, once again inhabits the waters of Rocky Mountain National Park. We will stroll the well-maintained flat path around Lily Lake (approximately 1/2 mile) discussing the Greenback's story – from how this particular trout became the only native trout to this area of the Rockies to how it was re-discovered and re-established in Rocky Mountain National Park.

Wednesday

8:30am – 1:00pm: Scenic Hike to Dream Lake – Rocky Mountain National Park*

Dream Lake is one of the most photographed lakes in Rocky Mountain National Park. Situated in the Tyndall Gorge between the summit of Flattop and the jutting false summit of Hallet Peak, Dream Lake has a truly apt name as it epitomizes the high mountain lakes of the Rocky Mountains. The route is 2.2 miles round trip with plenty of stops to take in the breathtaking scenery. You will want to remember the camera for this hike!
